COMPETITOR ENTRY FEE:

One division: \$40.00 USD. Additional division: \$40.00 USD. Point Fighting Team \$150.00 USD

AWARDS:

Medal will be awarded to the first, second and two third places for each division, according to the Olympic system.

Awards: Gold, silver and 2 Bronze

ATHLETES

- All athletes, coaches and judges must stay at the host hotel, its mandatory.
- Accommodation must be at least 5 nights & 4 days; the hotel rate will be respected 3 days before and 3 days after the event.
- Hotel reservation and payment must be done to WAKO National representative through WAKO Trinidad and Tobago
- Confirm your reservation paying 25% of the total amount by 30th April.
- Another payment of 25% should be done by 31st May.
- Balance to Complete payment must be done by 30th June.

The athletes must be part of their country's Tertiary Education System.

Athletes could participate in one or more categories: Point Fighting, Kick Light and Creative Forms.

Competition registration and payment must be done by WAKO National representative, through the Tertiary / University Sport Association to WAKO TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO.

ONLINE REGISTRATION

Will open on Wednesday 1st May and will close on Sunday 30th June.

Late registrations will be1st -10th July at a US \$10.00 late fee

No competition registrations will be acceptable after that date 10th July

Each Tertiary Sport Association President must make the registration of his National Team with the user name and password which will be given. No athlete will be allowed to make his/her individual registration.

SAFETY:

Athlete must have the complete personal protection equipment mentioned in WAKO IF Rules according to the category in which he/she will participate.
Athletes should provide a medical certification (no longer that 30 days)
Signed by the authorized Doctor, in which it is stated that prior to leaving his/her country the athlete was in good physical condition and not suffering from any injury, infection or disability to affect his/her capacity to compete in the 1st Pan American University Championship.





LIABILITY:


