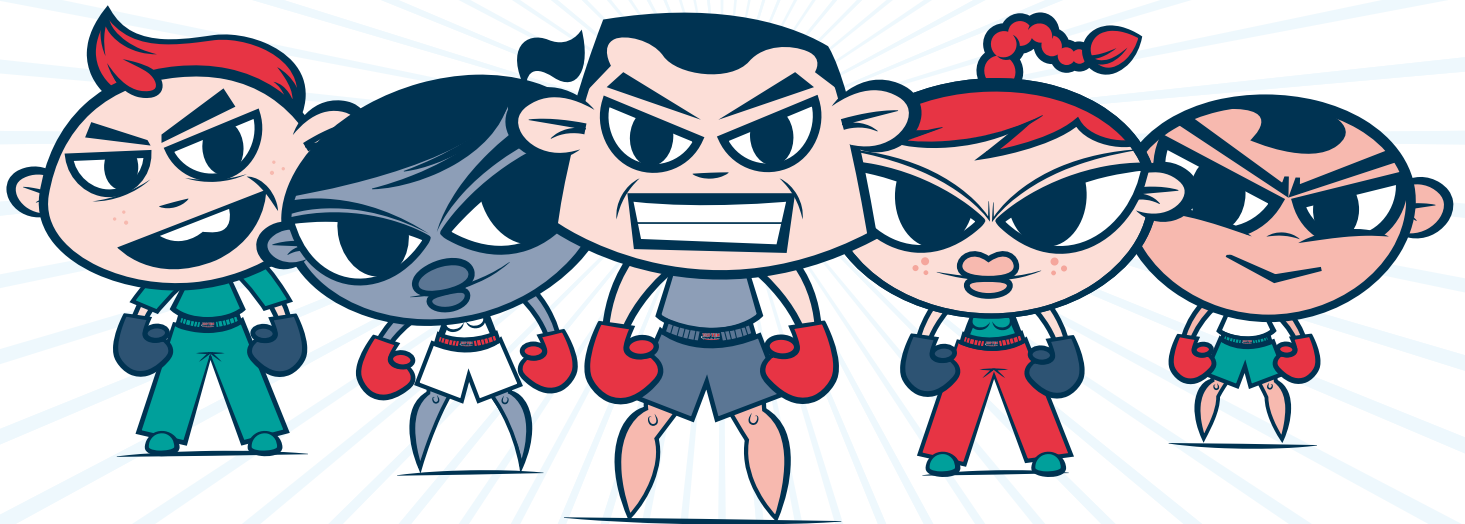

## HOST CITY, GYŐR

Győr is the sixth largest city in Hungary, with just under 130,000 inhabitants. Its excellent geographical location, advanced industry, and highly qualified workforce make it one of the most dynamically developing innovative cities of the country. The so-called Golden Triangle of Vienna, Budapest and Bratislava, the airport in Pécs, the international river harbour in Gönyű, the international railroad connections, as well as the M1 highway have helped Győr to become one of the most important economic and industrial centres in Hungary.

Situated near the confluence of no fewer than four rivers, Győr is truly “a city of rivers.” Its atmosphere is dominated by the Moson Danube meandering through the city, as well as its erstwhile eponymous Rába (Raab). One may as well go punting or on a boat trip to discover the architectural monuments of Győr, but walking through the inner city allows one to roam amidst mansions from historic periods, characteristic corner balconies, and statues. It is worth visiting the basilica, founded almost a millennium ago, where one can behold one of Hungary’s national relics, the Herma of St Ladislaus. The tower of the Bishop’s Palace opens a panoramic perspective on the city, with the view extending as far as Pannonhalma, some 20 kilometres from Győr, where the Benedictine Arch-abbey is located – one of Hungary’s 8 UNESCO World Heritage sites.

## 1 | CITY HALL, BAROSS STREET



**CITY HALL:** A true emblem of the town of Győr, this eclectic building was inaugurated in 1900. On its facade we see a coat of arms donated by Maria Theresa. From its 59-metre tower a popular folk tune from the Small Plain region is heard in every hour, while at 11am and 5pm it plays a two-minute musical composition.

**FOUNTAIN:** It symbolises the town of rivers, where the Mosoni Danube, Rába and Rábca rivers meet. On various occasions throughout the day, the fountain plays a tune, while at night we can marvel at its illuminated glory.

**BAROSS ÚT:** Always buzzing with life, at the entrance of the town's shopping street visitors are welcomed by the statue of Gábor Baross, Hungary's former minister of transport. A few steps away, a row of red bricks reminds us to the former Fehérvár Gate, the explosion of which in 1598 marked the beginning of the town's reconquest from the four-year Ottoman occupation. On the opposite side, a memorial plaque prompts us to remember the former iconic fire tower (1792-1894), which served as the inspiration for the design of the City Hall's main tower. In the middle of the road, a statue dubbed by the locals as the "Boatman" reminds us to the last devastating flood (1954).

**Interesting note:** The street was renovated in 1997, a project backed by a number of local businesses and private individuals. A bench is dedicated to each of them for their financial support. Let's take a closer look at the name plates!

Take a left at the statue of Saint George the Dragon Slayer, and continue our stroll down Kazinczy street.





## 2 | BÉCSI KAPU SQUARE



The square was once home to one of the town gates, the Vienna Gate.

### CARMELITE CHURCH:

Completed in 1725, one of the peculiarities of the Carmelite church and monastery is a Baroque St. Mary statue located in one of the small chambers. We can also admire the church's beautiful Baroque interior and the black chapel, built on the model of the Loreto chapel.

**SCULPTURE OF KISFALUDY:** The sculpture of the famous writer has attracted a number of local legends. If we are not careful enough and park in the red zone, he jots down the number plate, while students who are late from school are not safe from his notebook either.

**CASTLE, CANNONS:** The Castle in its current shape and form originates from the 16th and 17th centuries. One of its peculiarities is the "Füles bástya" (New Bastion), which proved as a handy instrument while defending the castle from the Turks.

**RADÓ ISLAND:** Located in between the two arms of the river Rába, the island is a popular rest area among locals and home to the country's oldest boathouse.

**SYNAGOGUE:** Today, one of Hungary's largest Neolog synagogues (1870) is a concert and event hall that houses the private collection of János Vasilescu Sr., showcasing the visual art of the 20th-century Hungary.

**A DETOUR TO KIRÁLY STREET:** The building under number 4 was named after a famous guest, Napoleon. The emperor "left" a keepsake after the battle of 1809; vigilant bystanders can find a cannon ball he had thrown to the opposite side of the street.

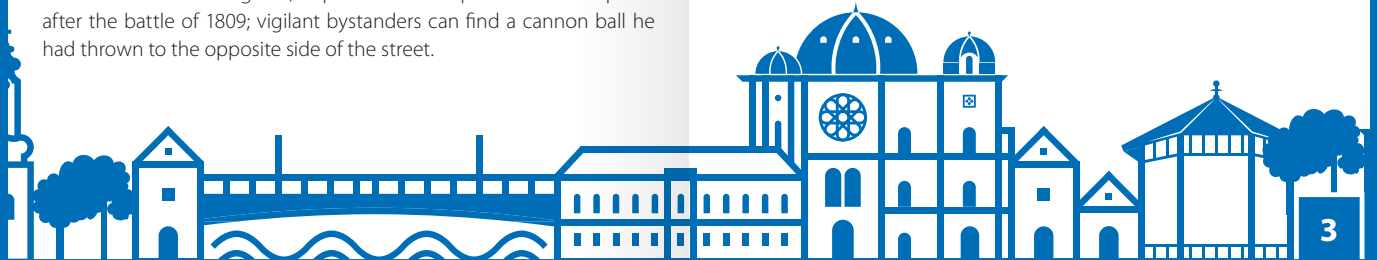
## 3 | CHAPTER HILL



**STONE OF THE VIRGIN MARY:** This work of art completed in 2000 by Tibor Szervátiusz is dedicated to the millennial anniversary of the founding of the Hungarian state. Its main scene depicts St. Stephen as he offers our nation to the Virgin Mary. On the two sides we see the legend of the "Miraculous Deer" (Csodaszarvas) coming to life.

**CATHEDRAL:** Built in Roman style in the 11th century, the Cathedral is the single most symbolic church within the Diocese of Győr, established by St. Stephen. The current appearance of its interior was shaped by Baroque architecture in the 1780s. Since Pope John Paul II's visit in 1996, the Cathedral has held basilica minor rank, while its importance is underlined by three important relics. Its northern aisle features the Weeping Madonna painting, which was rescued from Ireland in 1655. On 17 March 1697, on St. Patrick's Day, the painting wept blood. On the other side, the Gothic chapel built to the aisle in the 15th century guards one of the nation's most significant relics. The herm of St. Ladislaus, a bust decorated with gold and gemstones, conceals the knight-king's skull. In this chapel we also find the tomb of the martyr Blessed Bishop Vilmos Apor.

**OLD CHURCH FROM THE EARLY-ÁRPÁD DYNASTY:** These 10th-century ruins are the foundations of the old church from the early-Árpád dynasty. Next to it we see the statue of St. Michael archangel as he triumphantly thrusts Lucifer, the epitome of evil, from the Heavens to the underworld.



After a quick stop at Sarkantyús lane, we take a left to continue our walk towards Chapter Hill.

Inside Győr's most historic part enter the Cathedral and take a stroll around the building. After a visit to the Bishop's Castle, we can spend time to visit the other exhibitions on Chapter Hill.





**STATUE OF ST. LADISLAUS:** A bronze statue behind the Cathedral also honours our knight-king, St. Ladislaus. The inscription reads: "A head taller than everyone else."

**BISHOP'S CASTLE:** Situated at the heart of Győr's inner city, the Bishop's Castle and its buildings are the centre of the Diocese of Győr, established by our king Stephen I. Built in the 13th century, the tower offers a magnificent panorama, while in its cellar we can visit a contemporary exhibition presenting the local events of World War II and commemorating the life of Blessed Vilmos Apor, who suffered a martyr's death in that very place.

**THEOLOGICAL COLLEGE OF GYŐR:** The Neoclassical building that many believe to be a castle is home to the Theological College and Seminary of Győr.

## 4 | DUNAKAPU SQUARE



Besides Széchenyi square, the town's renewed event square is home to Győr's largest festivals. Below the square, on the -1st level of the underground parking garage we can look at the remnants of the former castle wall.



**SCHWARZENBERG-PÁLFY STATUE:** Situated at the foot of Kossuth Bridge, the statue was erected on the 400th anniversary of the town's reconquest from the Ottoman occupation.



**PULSE SCULPTURE:** Along the Mosoni Danube, we see Győr's most recent sculpture, which presents us the entire city panorama as we turn it around 360 degrees.



**SCULPTURE OF THE IRON ROOSTER:** During the castle's reconquest, the Hungarians were aided by a prophecy saying when the iron rooster, erected by the Turks as a weathervane, decides to crow and the half moon beneath it will turn into a full moon, granting the castle once again to the Hungarian army. The fulfilment of the prophecy was greatly helped by a trumpeting shoemaker's apprentice, who had climbed over the castle walls during the night to wait for dawn to break.



Let's follow the former castle walls towards Dunakapu square.

After testing our strength by turning around the Pulse sculpture, let's take a turn once again towards the inner city through Jedlik street.



## 5 | GUTENBERG SQUARE



**KRESZTA HOUSE:** This 17th-century heritage building is home to the collection of Győr-born ceramic artist Margit Kovács.

**SODA-WATER SIPHON:** It is not by chance that we find a giant soda-water siphon in Győr's town centre. Ányos Jedlik, former teacher at the Benedictine school, priest and inventor, also patented the industrial production of carbonated water. And why is Győr renowned as the city of "fröccs" (spritzer)? During a grape harvest in Fót, Jedlik sought to quench his companions' thirst with a mixture of white wine and carbonated water produced with the help of his soda siphon. The drink became to be known as spritzer, in Hungarian "fröccs".



**ARK OF THE COVENANT:** The town's most dazzling sculpture tells an exciting story. In 1729, a soldier accused of bigamy found refuge in a former Jesuit monastery. His pursuers imposed a blockade on the building. Taking advantage of the procession of the Holy Sacrament, the fugitive attempted to escape dressed as an altar boy, but was easily recognised. During the manhunt, the Holy Sacrament was knocked from the high priest's hands, which fell to the ground shattering into a million little pieces. Two years later, at the emperor's order a beautiful sculpture was erected from the soldiers' pay.



**GOLDEN SHIP TRADE SIGN:** Work of art made by local goldsmith Bandi Schima, whose letter – according to legend – is still preserved in the ship hull.

## 6 | SZÉCHENYI SQUARE



Győr's compelling Baroque main square with a water feature in the summer months, is the centre of the city's life and events.

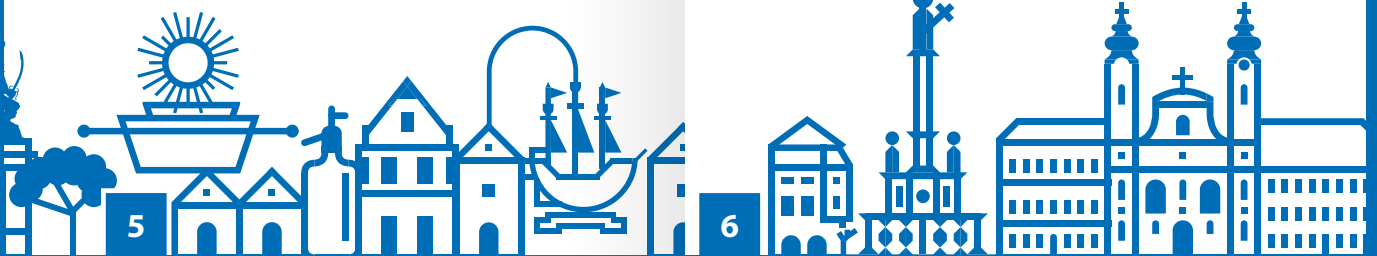
**ESTERHÁZY PALACE** (Király u. 17): The building is currently functioning as the principal location of Flóris Rómer Art and History Museum and it houses the permanent exhibition of the Dr. Béla Radnai collection. Featured on the balcony above the gate, we can see the original owner's initials, C(omes) G(abriel) E(sterházy).

**"IRON STOCK HOUSE"** (Széchenyi tér 4): Legend has it that the building was named after the old trade sign under the corner-balcony, the "iron stock", which was covered in nails that journeymen had knocked into it when they came to Győr.

**LORD ABBOT'S HOUSE** (Széchenyi tér 5): It was built by the archabbot of Pannonhalma in 1741–1742. This splendid Baroque palace is home to the exhibition on local history.

**OLD CITY HALL** (Rákóczi u. 1.): In 1848, Lajos Kossuth delivered a recruiting speech to the people of Győr from its forged-iron balcony.

**COLUMN OF ST. MARY:** The monument at the centre of the square was erected by local bishop Lipót Kollonich, in 1686, to commemorate the town's reconquest from Turkish occupation.



Continuing straight on Jedlik street we soon reach Széchenyi square, Győr's central square.

Taking a left at the pharmacy museum on Czuczor street, we soon find ourselves at the Theatre on II. János Pál square.







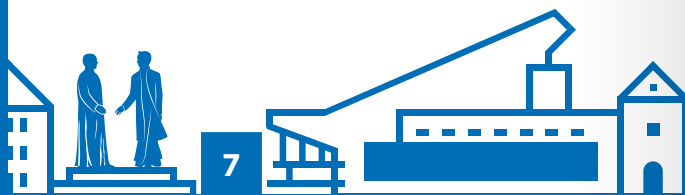
**BENEDICTINE BUILDINGS:** Church, monastery, school were built by Jesuits in the 17th century. Still in its original function, the Baroque-style pharmacy museum also features a local invention, the gastric stapler.

**STATUE OF ÁNYOS JEDLIK AND GERGELY CZUCZOR:** Two distinguished former teachers of the Benedictine school, inventor and physicist Jedlik and literary man Czuczor were cousins and also close friends.

## 7 | NATIONAL THEATRE OF GYŐR



Inaugurated in 1978, the building's southern and northern facades feature works of op art by Victor Vasarely. Inside the theatre we find large paintings on porcelain by Endre Szász. Awaiting avid theatre-goers with a colourful range of programmes, the National Theatre of Győr is also home of the Ballet of Győr.

Our greatest concerns are for the safety of the participants, and that at the completion of these Championships there will have been no incidents, which would reflect poorly on any individuals, teams, or organizations. We ask for your co-operation and responsibility toward these ends.

### STATEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY

I recognize my responsibility for the entire behavior of the athletes of my team throughout their participation in the WAKO CHILDREN, CADETS & JUNIORS EUROPEAN KICKBOXING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2019 GYŐR HUNGARY. These responsibilities began at the time of their first arrival and conclude after their final departure from the event, event site or other site which might be related to their participation in this event. This includes complete supervision while athletes are in their respective competition for the purpose of these Championships. I also recognize that discipline problems arise in the late evening after the conclusion of the competition, in the form of not obeying the quiet hours between 09:00 pm and 7:00 am, and especially on the last night of the event. I also recognize that the Organizing Committee, the Event Coordinator, and the Staff at each competitive site will be available to help control discipline problems and make the event enjoyable for all.

### USE OF ALCOHOL AND DRUGS BY PARTICIPANTS IS PROHIBITED

State laws prohibit the use of alcohol by minors (under 18 years of age) and the possession or use of drugs. These laws will be strictly enforced by, team chaperon, and tournament officials. Any participant found in violation of these laws may be subject to prosecution by law enforcement officers and they and their teammates will be immediately expelled from the Championship. The Chief of Delegation assumes responsibility for the monitoring player conduct to ensure that drinking and drug use laws are upheld.

### DAMAGE TO PLAYING SITES

Should damage occur at any site by any participant or even an athlete's parent the team responsible will be charged for the damages and the participant of this team will not be admitted to any WAKO Championships. If the responsible individual/team cannot be determined, then all teams participating at the site during the occurrence will be sanctioned from future WAKO Championships. We feel it is the responsibility of all teams, competitors, coaches, and families to ensure that the site is free of any problems and damages. In addition the area of the arena your team occupies is to be free of trash when you leave your site. Violators will cause their team to be immediately disqualified and dismissed from the Championships.

### ARENA CONDUCT

ATHLETES WILL ABIDE BY WAKO RULES REGARDING ARENA CONDUCT. At all time coaches, team, opponents, and officials will be treated with the utmost respect. Coaches must also assume full responsibility for enforcing arena conduct rules. Teams that fail to abide by these rules are subject to disciplinary action (e.g. dismissal from the event).

### COACH and OFFICIALS ENDORSEMENT

I certify that I have read the Code of Conduct and have carefully reviewed it with my team members. All participants in the Championship, athletes, coaches, chaperons and relatives are expected to abide by the above-discussed Code of Conduct. It is the responsibility of every Chief of Delegates, coaches, chaperons to review with their teams this Code of Conduct. Individual and team violators of any provisions of this Code may be excluded from further participation in WAKO events.
