WAKO World Championships Final Update:

It is IMPERATIVE that you read and understand this protocol in its entirety. There will be NOT exception to the rules. Not know or not understanding will not be acceptable as an excuse, we are in special times and must protect the integrity of the majority and entire program of sport for the full week.

The LOC has organized that there is NO requirement to quarantine when entering Italy for the championships.

PROCEDURES FOR ANTI COVID-19 SECURITY CONTROL Applicate to all participants at championships

The Ordinance of 28 August 2021 valid until 25 October 2021 issued by the Ministry of Health explains in detail the procedures for entering the national territory of foreigners: www.salute.gov.it

Important news for the World Championship, therefore a sporting event recognized by Federkombat, CONI and WAKO, is contained by clicking on the **Exemptions DEROGHE** button. It is well highlighted that all delegations that will take part in the event must NOT be quarantine.

The indications of the Ministry of Health are reported. Exemptions activated only with self-declaration without the need for authorization from the Ministry of Health.

"Exemptions for admissions for national sports competitions that take place in Italy"

"Participants in competitions that take place exclusively on the Italian territory and that meet specific conditions identified in Article 18 of the Prime Ministerial Decree of 2 March 2021 can benefit from this exemption.

Each beneficiary must fill out the <u>Passenger Locator Form</u> - Digital localization form - before entering Italy, therefore it is not necessary to request this exemption from the Ministry of Health.

Particularly

- The current legislation applies to the entry of athletes, technicians, judges, race officials and accompanying persons, representatives of the foreign press for participation in sports competitions that take place in Italy and comply with the provisions of art. 18, paragraph 1, of the Prime Ministerial Decree of 2 March 2021.
- It is mandatory that in the **48 hours** prior to entry into Italy, the aforementioned categories have undergone a molecular or antigen test, carried out by means of a swab and negative result.

Entries are also allowed from those countries from which entry into Italy is prohibited as per art. 49 paragraph 5, of the Prime Ministerial Decree of 2 March 2021.

The reference organizations for this exemption are CONI and CIP (Article 18, paragraph 1). Participants are required to comply with the protocols issued by the respective national and international sports federations, associated sports disciplines and sports promotion bodies.

Therefore, all Delegations leaving for Italy must follow the following:

Requirements for entry into Italy

- fill in the Passenger Locator Form before departure and present it to anyone in charge of checks
- submit the COVID-19 Green Certification in one of the following languages: Italian, English, French or Spanish; the Certification must certify one of the following conditions:
 - a) have completed the prescribed anti-SARS-CoV-2 vaccination course for at least 14 days, or
 - b) be cured of COVID-19 (the validity of the certificate of healing is 180 days from the date of the first positive swab), **or**
 - c) having undergone a **molecular or antigenic swab carried** out in the **48 hours** before entering Italy with negative results. Children under the age of 6 are exempted from taking the pre-departure swab.

An Anti Covid19 Health Control Plan is planned in line with:

- 1. The Health Protocol of the WAKO Medical Commission;
- 2. The Ordinance of the Ministry of Health;
- 3. The Guidelines of the Department of Sport of the Italian Government;
- 4. The Directives of the Italian Olympic Committee (CONI);

ALL the participants in the World Championship, in any capacity and role, are obliged to follow the indications of the aforementioned Protocol which we summarize below:

ALL

- 1. Register on the Sport Data website by filling in all Uploading the MANDATORY documents required and necessary to take a part at event;
- 2. Inquire before departure and follow the transport carriers' protocols for entry into Italy.

Upon arrival:

- 1. Go directly to the Sport Hall in Jesolo for the Anti covid 19 control procedure as an entire team;
- 2. To approach in a contingent way and NOT to mix with other Groups; a schedule for each team will be sent one week before the event, where the named team must arrive at weight control and registration within fifteen minutes of the designated time. This will be sent to President and Chief Coach or chief Delegation.

- 3. Fill in the Self-declaration form on the Sport Data platform. Operation that must be repeated every day;
- 4. Go to the Pass Collection point;
- 5. Run a quick antigen test and wait for the result. The test must be done by EVERYONE, including the vaccinated:
- 6. In case of negativity, follow the procedure for accreditation, weight control and medical examination;
- 7. In case of positive, follow the indications of the health workers who will carry out a Molecular Test (PCR);
- 8. Go to the chosen hotel;
- 9. Entrance to the sports hall will be limited by times and categories of membership (Athletes, Coaches, Referees, Staff, etc.) who will have SEPARATE entrances and spaces; No entry to arena unless you are within the schedule to compete, coach or referee.
- 10. It will be absolutely forbidden to move from one's own areas indicated in the PASS (with different colors); Athletes/coaches will NOT be permitted in spectators arena.
- 11. At the end of 96 hours ALL participants must repeat the rapid antigen test at the Sport Hall;
- 12. For the return travel it will be possible to carry out certified Molecular Tests (PCR) for a fee on site. The certificate can also be issued in English. Cost 50 Euro. It is required to book this test with Mrs. Serena Capiotto serena@belmondobooking.com on the form that will be sent separately.

Note for **Supporters**:

- 1. Register on the Sport Data Platform in the **supporter** section by uploading the required data and documents;
- 2. Upon arrival, follow the delegation to the sports hall for all accreditation procedures;
- 3. The entrance to the Sport Hall to follow the competition will be allowed to PASS holders who have registered in the time and manner provided;
- 4. There is an area reserved for supporters with a dedicated entrance and SEAT with a number;
- 5. Access is limited and in the assigned places. Obligation to sit in your seat with the mask on AT ALL TIMES;
- 6. The holders of Green Pass and / or Certificate of vaccination carried out, repeat the antigen test every 96 hours:
- 7. Attention: all those (<u>Supporters and Presidents</u>) without vaccination certificate are obliged to perform Molecular Swab (PCR) every 48 hours at their own expense (€50 per test);
- 8. The certified test, also in English, can be performed on the spot for a fee by the medical staff (cost 50 Euro).
